COURSE CONTENT

Section 1: Transition Assessment: Knowing the Options and How to Use Them – Learn the definition and intent of transition assessment, where to find a variety of assessments and how to use them, and tips for mastering their use.

Section 2: Assessing and Teaching Self-Determination Skills to Students, What Are the Options? – Learn the definition of self-determination (SD), the components of SD, ways to assess and promote SD, and ways to increase SD practices.

Section 3: Tips and Strategies for Mastering Engagement with Students and Families in the Transition Planning Process – Identify challenges to engagement, explore checklists for mastering engagement and identify key priorities for increasing student and family preparation for transition planning.
